## ADA Web Rule Overview (ADA.gov Fact Sheet)

- 1. Technical Standard: WCAG 2.1 AA
- 2. State and local governments must comply with **website** and **mobile application** requirements. View the ADA's A Small Entity Compliance Guide to learn more.
- 3. The website and mobile app content **3rd party vendors** develop for you is included in requirement. View the ADA's <u>summary of the exceptions</u>.
- 4. Compliance dates vary depending on the size of your entity (see below).

## **Compliance Dates**

State and local government size	Compliance date
0 to 49,999 persons	April 26, 2027
Special district governments	April 26, 2027
50,000 or more persons	April 24, 2026

## Planned Compliance

- 1. **Policies**: Have a plan and communicate it to your agency and the public
- 2. **Process**: Plan and document how you will make accessibility happen in your agency. Then use it!
- 3. **Training**: Accessibility can't be "Googled." And it changes a lot. Ongoing training is crucial.

## **User Impacts**

- Blind/Low Vision: Properly marked navigation points
- Hearing: Correct captioning, transcripts, and sign language
- Motor Skill: Smooth navigation and selection options
- Neurodivergence/Cognitive: Clear content and good organization
