FROM THE IDEA OF A "GATHERING SPACE TO AN ACTUAL PLACE FOR COMMUNITY



- Full-Service YMCA with a gym, pool, exercise studios, walking track, weight room, and cardio options
- YMCA-operated day care for 100+ children
- Essentia Health Clinic Physical Therapy and more
- Community Space, Lounge, Café
- 78,000 square feet
- Total Project Costs \$26 million
 - \$16 million Sales Tax
 - \$8 million State Bonding
 - \$2 million Essentia Naming Rights



TIMELINES & KEY STEPS

- This was a multi-year process with several big pieces & partners needing coordination and collaboration
- Community-led effort with Community Steering Committee



DESTINY DRIVER - 2011

- Identify and define a community gathering site and its master plan for development within two years
- April 28, 2021



KEY COMPONENTS - 2012

Operator Determination

- Several 2012 meetings with the YMCA
- They were looking to expand beyond downtown Duluth
- We said we would love to have a facility in Hermantown
- Funding Unrelated to project
 - Hermantown City Council supports/obtains legislative approval to increase sales tax from ½ to 1 percent in November 2012
 - It passes voter referendum ... by 12 votes!

PLAN FORMULATION - 2013

- Citizen-led committee
- Significant efforts from the YMCA
- Identifying the "hook" of wellness and health outcomes
- Identifying the plan



HEALTH OUTCOMES – SOUTH ST. LOUIS COUNTY 2014

- City Council adopts resolution supporting regional health and wellness center, and requests state bonding for the "Arrowhead Regional Health and Wellness Center
- City Council agreement with the YMCA for consulting services
- City obtains \$250,000 in pre-design grant in May of 2014
- City hires LHB for pre-design efforts



CREATING PARTNERSHIPS - 2015

- Letters of Intent with Hermantown Schools Donation of the land and aging (brownfield) school building
- Letters of Intent with Essentia Health naming partner for "Essentia Regional Health and Wellness Center" – later shortened to today's "Essentia Wellness Center"
- Legislative efforts to secure state bonding



FUNDING - 2016

- Legislative Efforts
 - Use of Sales Tax for Essentia Wellness Center passes legislature
 - Hope to secure bonding ... bonding bill does not happen
- Referendum to allow the use of existing 1% sales tax
 - Does not increase the rate of the 2012 vote
 - No dollar limit on project (beyond collected tax)
 - Rules on sales tax have subsequently changed



BONDING & DESIGN - 2017

- City awarded \$8 million in state bonding May of 2017
- City hires LHB as architect, McGough as construction manager
- City begins negotiations with YMCA for use and operations agreement
 - Operation without ongoing subsidy from City

Ground Breaking July 10, 2018 First Tip Up Panel – October 8, 2018



GRAND OPENING – OCTOBER 8, 2019



COMMUNITY GATHERING PLACE

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- **RESIDENTS DID NOT PAY A SINGLE CENT MORE**



OPERATIONS 2019 - 2024

- 2019 Opened at membership and visitor levels expected at the five-year mark
- 2020 Closed for four months due to pandemic
 - Top Project award winner of 2019 from Finance & Commerce
- 2024 10,000 members (equivalent to City population
 - More than 1,000 daily visitors
 - More than 100 children on day care wait list



BETTER TOGETHER

- "Better Together" became the informal motto
 - The community came together to make this happen
 - The great partnerships helped make it possible
- Gathering Place
 - Through process and creation of place; both served as an opportunity to serve and build community
